Guest Speaker: Anita Weisbord

Anita is a Holocaust survivor and was a participant in Britain's Kindertransport program that saved some 10,000 European children from Nazi hands.

Put yourself in the following situation:

You have two small children, ages 2 and 5 and you are living in a war zone where children are targeted for extermination. An opportunity to save your children and send them to England on the *Kindertransport* presents itself, What should you do?

- 1. Send your children into the arms of strangers who will bring them to another country and have a chance at survival... but will they remain Jewish?
- 2. Keep your children with you, with the awareness that you might all perish together.

This was the dilemma faced by some of the Jews who lived through the Holocaust, and this is the issue we will tackle during our program.
