

Summer Positions

Seasonal Day Camp Sports Specialist Counselor

The Sports specialist is responsible for the development of curriculum and the safe supervision and administration of sports programming at camp in multiple daily sessions for groups grades K through 4. Specialists also assist general counselors during lunch and swim. Must have experience with a wide variety of sports instruction and curriculum development. Applicants must be at least 20 years old. Physical educators and those pursuing this degree program are encouraged to apply. Candidates must be available for all pre-camp orientation in May and June TBD, as well as all days of camp June 26 through August 18, 2017. All others need not apply.

Seasonal Day Camp Arts & Crafts Specialist Counselor

The Arts & Crafts specialist is responsible for the planning, implementation and supervision of art projects at camp, in multiple daily sessions for groups grades K through 4. Specialists also assist general counselors during lunch and swim. Applicants must be at least 20 years old and have a background in arts & crafts and experience with children. Art education majors are encouraged to apply. Must be available for pre-camp orientation in May and June TBD, as well as all days of camp June 26 through August 18, 2017.

Seasonal Day Camp Science Specialist Counselor

The Science Specialist is responsible for the planning, implementation and supervision of a hands-on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Math) program at camp, including low-tech hands-on activities and nature programs, in multiple daily sessions for groups grades K through 4. Specialists also assist general counselors during lunch and swim. Applicants must be at least 20 years old and have a background in education or STEM subject areas, as well as experience working with children. Must be available for pre-camp orientation in May and June TBD, as well as all days of camp June 26 through August 18, 2017.

Seasonal Day Camp Judaic Culture Specialist Counselor

The Judaic Culture specialist will be responsible for planning and implementing creative Judaic programs for school age campers, which encourage growth and education of Jewish principles, as well as develop weekly Shabbat specific programming. Responsible to the Assistant Director and Director of camp, the Judaic Culture Specialist will infuse Jewish flavor into the camp atmosphere and promote concepts of Judaism including an appreciation of Israel. The Judaic Culture Specialist will serve as a resource to all staff, and assist in this respect with pre-camp orientation.

Applicant must be at least 20 years old and have had prior direct Judaic education experience working with school age children, as well as significant camp experience. Specialists also assist counselors during lunch and swim. Must be available for pre-camp orientation in May and June TBD, as well as all days of camp June 26 through August 18, 2017.

Seasonal Day Camp Senior Counselors

Looking for energetic and motivated individuals for senior day camp counselor positions. Transportation is available. This position will require traveling on day and overnight trips. Applicants must be at least 18 years old and have prior experience working with school age children, grades K – 6. Prior experience in a camp setting is preferred. Must be available for pre-camp orientation in May and June TBD, as well as all days of camp June 26 through August 18, 2017.

Seasonal Rec Teen Program Site Supervisor

The Site Supervisor will plan and administer the day camp recreation program for 7th and 8th graders, supervise staff, and oversee all aspects of the program including scheduling and trips. This is a seasonal position, requiring candidates to be available full time during the camp program in the summer months, as well as part-time for pre-camp staff recruitment and hiring, program planning and scheduling, staff training and all preparation leading up to camp as needed.

- Strong leadership skills and experience supervising staff
- Energetic and organized
- Proven experience working directly with pre-teens/teens
- At least one year experience in a day camp leadership position
